
Style Tips:

* For a fun look, pair your plaid with a modern twist. Mix scales or patterns, like pairing a micro-check top with a larger tartan skirt.


Make a Statement

* Accessories are a cost-effective refresh for the holiday season.


* So your pieces don't compete, choose no more than 2 bold accessories at a time.
